The next International Congress of Endocrinology (ICE) will be held in Rio de Janeiro, Brazil, on November 8- 12th, 2008, under the organization of the International Society of Endocrinology (ISE) and the Brazilian Society of Endocrinology and Metabolism (SBEM).

The International Society of Endocrinology (ISE) comprises national endocrine societies from over 60 countries, including many European countries. The Brazilian Society of Endocrinology and Metabolism (SBEM) is one of them: it is the third largest endocrine society of the world, with around 3000 members, and will be the first to shelter an ICE Congress in South America.

ISE President, Shlomo Melmed (USA), ICE Chairman, Amelio F. de Godoy Matos (Brazil) and the Chair of the program organizing committee, John Wass (UK), are all working hard with their groups, in order to prepare a congress to be remembered.
